Arper has always put flexibility at the forefront of our designs and promoted a sense of balance between work and personal life.


In the following proposals, we have taken some of our favorite designs and explored how they can be personalized and modified to adjust to the evolving needs of this time. With a core value of adaptability, Arper has created flexible furniture to meet the demands of the moment—and every moment to come.

Lobby Area
Public learning areas like lobbies can present an opportunity to rest, recharge, read, or meet in small groups—but at a safe distance. This configuration of Kiik makes the space between seating functional with a small, useful table.



Break Out Room

Break out areas are essential as informal places to work and exchange ideas. Paravan helps maintain creativity and an exchange of ideas while still safeguarding the space. Cross's expansive tabletop allows for up to 4 individuals at a table while still maintaining safe distancing practices.


Auditorium


